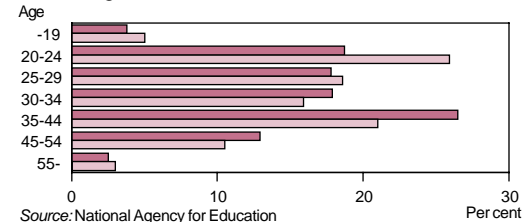

Persons in municipal adult education by age 1998/99

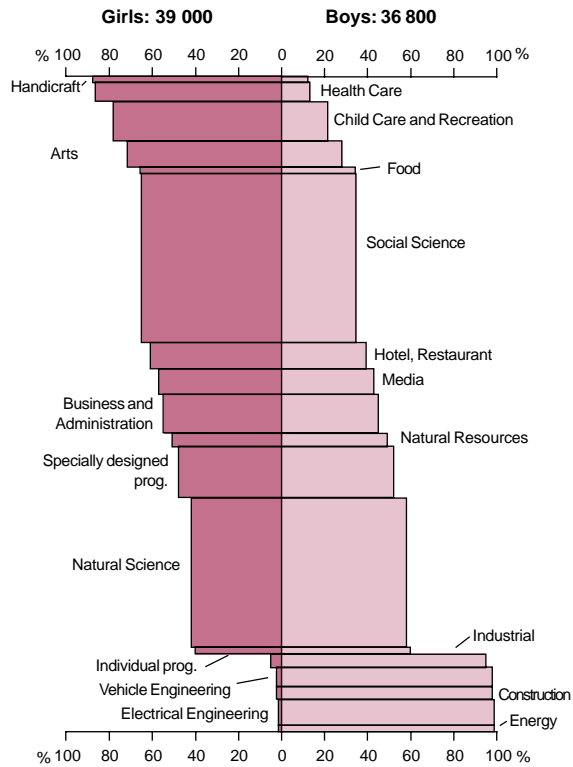
Percentage distribution

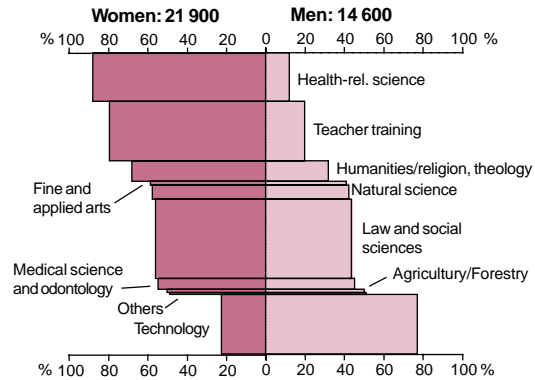
